22614VIC Certificate II in BUILDING & CONSTRUCTION CARPENTRY (*partial completion*)

The aim of this program is to provide young people with the opportunity to gain comprehensive entry-level training in the construction industry. The program may include: levelling, carpentry hand tools, calculations, floor and wall framing, roof framing and introduction to scaffolding. On successful completion of this program students will have completed two-thirds of the 22614VIC Certificate II in Building and Construction (Carpentry Pre-apprenticeship.)
