The Certificate III in Community Services offers students the opportunity to learn about the community services sector and explore specific contexts of work. Skills will be developed in communication, working with diversity, workplace health and safety, administration support, and responding to clients.

The course introduces students to the range of occupations in the community sector that may involve volunteering; advocacy, where you fight for the rights of your clients.

Working in community services, has an impact on the welfare of vulnerable people. Work in this field helps to build stronger, more inclusive communities. Related jobs in community services include aged care; disability services; indigenous and

multicultural support; asylum seekers and refugee services; mental health and counselling; child protection; family services; schools; emergency relief; youth justice; and housing and community development.

Community service workers have the ability to work in all the major sectors: not-for-profit, government and private.

On the successful completion of the 2 year program, VCE students may receive up to three units at Units 1 and 2 level and two Units 3 and 4 sequence and credits in the Industry Specific Skills Strand for VCAL students.
