Do you want to learn carpentry skills in Melton's Trade Training Centre at Staughton College and pursue a career in the Building & Construction industry? Federation University is the RTO (TOID) 4909.



The Carpentry stream of the Certificate II in Building and Construction (Pre-Apprenticeship) provides you with the knowledge and skills to enhance your employment prospects in the building and construction industry.

The program is completed over 2 years and offers a partial completion of the pre-apprenticeship. It provides foundation carpentry skills and includes units such as safe handling and use of plant and power tools, quality principles for the construction industry, calculations and workplace documents and plans.

The program is designed for students wishing to gain employment or undertake further training in the building and construction industry, with a direct pathway to an Apprenticeship or School Based Apprenticeship in Building & Construction with recognition of prior learning for units completed.

Completing this course provides credit at Units 1–2 and Units 3–4 within the VCE and credits in the Industry Specific Skills Strand for VCAL students.
