CERTIFICATE II IN SALON ASSISTANT SHB20216

Melton Secondary College's Trade Training Centre Salon offers the Salon Assistant (Hairdressing) course. The course provides you with entry level skills to work in the hair and beauty industry. Federation TAFE is the RTO (TOID) 4909.



The Certificate II in Salon Assistant develops basic skills and knowledge to assist with client services in the hairdressing, barbering and beauty industry, and provides a pathway into a hairdressing/barbering apprenticeship.

The program is completed over two (2) years, with 10 days of compulsory structured work placement to take place in Term 2 or 3 (5 days in Year 1 and 5 days in Year 2).

The course prepares you to work in a salon to undertake entry level tasks. It involves greeting clients and making appointments; applying colour; shampooing and drying hair; maintaining and organizing tools, equipment and work areas; following OHS and environmentally sustainable work practices; basic make-up application and selling products and services.

Certificate II in Salon Assistant over two years can provide a credit recognition of up to four units at Units 1 and 2 level towards a student's VCE. Completing this qualification also provides credits in the Industry Specific Skills Strand for VCAL students.

Completion of the course provides up to eight units credit transfer in the Certificate III in Hairdressing and Certificate III in Barbering.
