The Certificate III in Allied Health Assistance incorporating Certificate III in Health Services Assistance is offered at Catholic Regional College Melton. IVET Institute is the RTO (40548).



The Certificate III in Allied Health Assistance is suitable for students who have an interest in assisting Allied Health practitioners such as physiotherapists, speech pathologists, occupational therapist, podiatrists or who may be interested in patient care either within a hospital, nursing home, rehabilitation or medical care facility.

The course provides students with the knowledge and skills that will enhance their employment prospects in the Health industry.

The core units of the certificate are broad and aim to prepare students for the many different workplace activities they will be

asked to perform. In any health care setting, positive, professional carer patient relationships are essential and this is emphasized throughout the course.

On the successful completion of the 2 year program, VCE students receive credit of one unit at Units 1 and 2 level and three units at Units 3 and 4 level and VCAL students receive credit in the Industry Specific Skills Strand.
