Whether your interest is in fashion design, technology that involves the production of raw material (textiles or fibres); retail sales or styling, the Certificate II in Applied Fashion Design & Technology may be the start of your career in the fashion industry. The VCE VET Applied Fashion and Technology program offers a qualification which is recognised throughout Australia. This qualification provides students with a broad range of skills and knowledge to pursue a career or further training in the fashion industry.

A career in the fashion industry is diverse with many different roles. A fashion job can be anything from running photo shoots to managing a blog in the fashion media.

A garment technologist works on the design and development of new materials, testing new combinations of yarns, textiles and fibres. Technologists look at ways to improve the production techniques and quality control.

A fashion designer may specialise in sportswear; formal or bridal wear; handbags; childrens wear; mens or ladies fashion.

Completing this course provides credit at Units 1–2 and Units 3–4 within the VCE and credits in the Industry Specific Skills Strand for VCAL students.
